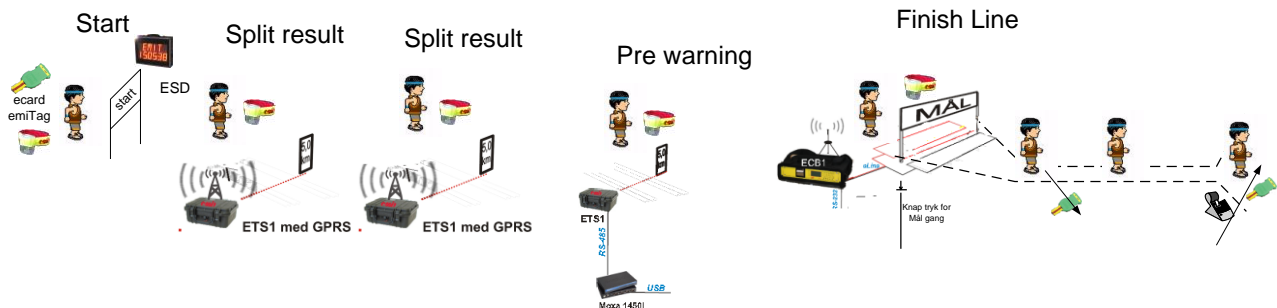

The EMIT controls used at all JWOC 2010 competitions are without acoustic or visual indication for a “stamp”. Correct physical contact is needed to ensure an electrical stamp (main system) and a mechanical punch in the backup card (backup system).

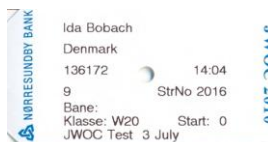
A missing or wrong stamp in the electrical system will result in a disqualification unless there is a clear and undoubtedly correct stamp in the backup card.



The eCard must be reset for at least 5 seconds before start. All Reset controls will have visual (Led) indication, so runners can see the eCard is reset correctly. For the avoidance of doubt a timed start is in operation for all races.

It is the competitor’s own responsibility to ensure that the eCard is reset at the start and that the backup card is marked so that it can be used if the electronic punch is missing.

After the finish line has been crossed the crew will read out data of the eCard to provide the runners with their split times. Please note that the total time shown will not be correct as the readout is after the finish.



The backup card must be mounted correctly in the eCard before start. The eCard is used to check that all controls on each course have been punched.



The emiTag is used for intermediate times from radio posts and triggering of the finish time as the runner crosses the finish line.

The EmiTag must throughout the competition be carried on the right upper arm. Carrying the emiTag any other way crossing the finish line will result in a disqualification.

Each competitor will be equipped a personal eCard and emiTag that must be used for all competitions.

New backup cards and number bibs will be available at the “team leaders” meeting before each competition.

At arrival to JWOC each nation must at the office pickup ecards and emiTags for all their competitors. It also includes number bibs and backup cards for the test on 3 July at the barracks distance approx. 1.5 km. This is an offer for the teams to test the timekeeping equipment.
